

## DonorTec Program

Sport and Recreation Tasmania would like to bring your attention to **DonorTec**, an exciting program available to assist Australian non-profit organisations to build their Information Communication Technology (ICT) capacity.

### **What is DonorTec?**

DonorTec provides access to donated and discounted technology products and services from companies such as Microsoft, Cisco, Symantec, Sophos and Kaspersky to eligible income tax exempt (ITE) Australian non-profit groups. Via this program non-profit organisations can access the latest products at significantly reduced costs.

The DonorTec Program is provided by *Connecting Up Australia* in partnership with *TechSoup Global*. Both are non-profit organisations that are part of a global partnership for technology donations.

### **Does your organisation qualify?**

To participate in the DonorTec program, organisations must be:

- Australian charities or non-profit organisations
- non-government entities
- have an Australian Business Number (ABN); and
- have income tax exempt (ITE) status formally recognised on the Australian Business Register.
- Not all organisations require income tax exempt status to be formally recognised on the Australian Business Register. It is possible for Tasmanian Gymnastics clubs to self assess their own income tax exemptions and still qualify.
