

2011 Nominations for Tasmania Sporting Hall of Fame

Nominations are now open for 2011 for the Tasmanian Sporting Hall of Fame.

If you are aware of any Tasmanian deserving this honour and meeting the Hall of Fame assessment criteria we encourage you to nominate them.

The Tasmanian Sporting Hall of Fame is one way we can acknowledge Tasmanians who have been the best in their sport, as well as preserve Tasmania's sporting heritage.

In 2010 four Tasmanian legends were inducted into the Hall of Fame: Darren Balmforth (rowing), Matthew Gilmore (cycling), Alastair Lynch (Australian Rules Football) and Bill Youd (woodchopping), swelling the ranks of Tasmania's highest regarded sporting champions to 107 members.

Nominators of successful inductees are invited to attend the induction ceremony as a guest of the Tasmanian Sporting Hall of Fame, with this year's induction ceremony to be held on Friday, 21 October, at the Tasmanian Institute of Sport in Launceston.
