

Congratulations to Olivia Burnett, Georgina Osborn and Camille O'Connor

Silver medal awarded to Georgina Osborn for placing 2nd on vault for the event, congratulations!

Tassie had 3 gymnasts attend the Women's National Championships in Perth.

Olivia Burnett was attending her 7th Nationals, the first time as a Level 10. On day 1 of the competition Olivia who was coming back from Injury had several falls on Beam which cost her dearly, finishing 18th overall. Day 2 saw Olivia starting on Beam where she had the highest scoring beam routine for Level 10, unfortunately the overall award for beam is determined as a combination of Day 1 and 2 combined. On day 2 results, Olivia finished 7th overall combined both days she finished 12th

Camille O'Connor and Georgina Osborn represented Tasmania at Level 7, George in her second National and Camille in her first. In day 1 both gymnasts performed at their highest level with George finishing in 18th place and Camille in 30th Place overall, this was enough for both Girls to Qualify for Finals. Camille competition in her first 2 day completion had a strong competition with 1 fall on bars finishing 31st overall, this was a great experience for Camille and should put her in good standing for future Nationals. Georgina went into Day 2 sitting in 2nd Place on Vault, George had an outstanding 2nd day of competition improving her score to finish 16th overall and produced an outstanding vault to finish 2nd on Vault at Level 7
