The event attracted 100 participants from around the state from level 4 to 10. Gymnasts performed amazing routines across all levels, with the most exciting skills and performances coming from our National Level 7 and 10 gymnasts.

Tasmania will be represented at the Australian Championships in Perth in July by Georgina Osborn and Camille O'Connor (KSCG National Level 7) and Olivia Burnett (HGA National Level 10). At this event Georgina and Camille continued to improve their scores at Level 7 with both girls increasing the skill difficulty of their routines in preparation for the National Championships.
