

New Coaching Framework Launching in January

Gymnastics Australia is pleased to launch the new Coaching Framework which will be rolled out over the next three years.

The new Coaching Framework incorporates eight accreditations and four qualifications for the majority of Gymsports and is an extremely positive step forward in the development of the Gymsport coaching pathways.

Key milestones to note in the roll out of the new coaching framework include:

January 2013:

- The new Beginner coaching course will be piloted in selected states. Contact your State Association Member for further information.
- Community consultation will begin on the Intermediate and Advanced courses for each of the Gymsports. Please [click here](#) if you would like further information about the resource review.

March / April 2013:

- Current coaches will be transitioned into the new framework in selected states.

July 2013:

- All remaining states will transition to the new coaching framework and commence conducting courses under the new framework.

Throughout 2013:

- Current Presenters and Assessors will complete a bridging course in preparation for delivery of the new coaching courses. The bridging course has already been piloted in three States.
- Supervisors will participate in training towards the end of 2013 to gain the knowledge and skill required to supervise coaches coming out of the new Coaching Framework.
