- Set objectives for GT in regards to GA strategic priorities of: Engage and Enthuse, Enable, Excel and Endure
- Draft strategies for GT against the strategic priority areas for 2014-2016
- Interpret and create club level ownership of GA Values of: Leadership, Teamwork, Respect, Excellence, Integrity

GT board members will also be present at each of the forums to give an update on the GT governance review and pathway moving forwards.

SRT will collate all forum and member survey information to structure a draft strategic plan executive summary to mirror that of the GA Strategy 2013-16. This will then inform the GT Operational Plan to be completed by the GT board at later date.

The completed GT Strategy 2014-16 is to be tabled at the October 16, 2013 GT board meeting.
