

New Beginner Coach Course

The New Beginner Coach course will be launched in early March, with the online course available the week starting 11 March

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Tasmania is one of the four pilot states conducting the Beginner Coaching course under the new coaching framework

We understand that prospective coaches have been eagerly waiting for the launch of the new courses. The online component of the Beginner Coach course will be available the week starting 11 March.

What do I do?

- As soon as the online course is open go to the GA website and enrol yourself. Payment is due on enrolment and can be done via the website by credit or debit card through PayPal
- Work your way through the online course, you don't have to complete it in one sitting, you can log out any time you wish and come back later.
- Once you have successfully completed the course you can book yourself into the face to face, practical course. Gymnastics Tasmania is scheduling a course for 28th April and 12th May.

After successful completion of the Face to Face course you will be an accredited "Beginner Coach". This will qualify you to coach under supervision. Be aware that the Beginner course is generic and not sport specific. It is at the next level "Intermediate" that the courses become sport specific.

Cost for the Beginner Coach course will be as follows:

- Online course - \$100. This cost is paid directly to Gymnastics Australia
- Face 2 Face course - \$135

Technical membership is free upon successful completion of the Beginner Coaches Course (normally \$135).
